A RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the governing authority of each port and the governing authority of each
3	levee district to meet with area senators regarding its contract or direct hire employee
4	statistics and professional, personal, and consulting contracts.
5	WHEREAS, it is appropriate that there be legislative oversight of contract or direct
6	hire employee statistics, and professional, personal, and consulting services of ports and of
7	levee districts.
8	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
9	does hereby urge and request that the governing authority of each port and of each levee
10	district to meet with the senators representing each senatorial district in which the port or
11	levee district is located on or before April 1, 2017, and annually thereafter, to provide a
12	report for the previous calender year which shall include:
13	(1) A personnel table of all current employees including:
14	(a) Number of current employees and respective salary and vacant positions.
15	(b) For each current employee and vacant position, whether in classified or
16	unclassified civil service.
17	(c) Total number of current employees by race and gender.
18	(d) Number of administrative positions, filled and vacant and total number of

(2) List of each professional, personal, or consulting service contract in force, including type of professional service contemplated, general purpose, and contract amount.

(3) Hiring history for previous three years by race and gender.
