Amendments proposed by Representative Gary Carter to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 407 by Senator Milkovich

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 In Amendment No. 1 by the House Committee on Appropriations (#5010) on page 1, at the  
3 end of line 2, change "R.S. 39:1567(B)(3)" to "R.S. 39:1567(B)(3) and (4)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 In Amendment No. 2 by the House Committee on Appropriations (# 5010) on page 1, at the  
6 end of line 4, change "R.S. 39:1567(B)(3)" to "R.S. 39:1567(B)(3) and (4)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:

9 "(4) For purposes of Paragraph (3) of this Subsection,  
10 "information" shall include but not be limited to the following:

11 (a)(i) If a legal entity, the official name and domicile address of  
12 the contracting entity as reflected in documentation submitted to the  
13 secretary of state's office.

14 (ii) If a natural person, the full name and physical address of the  
15 contracting entity.

16 (b) If a legal entity, a complete and accurate listing of the owners  
17 of the contracting entity, whether in title or beneficial, unless it is a  
18 publicly traded entity, and a complete and accurate listing of the board  
19 of directors or equivalent governing body, if any, and officers, if any, of  
20 the contracting entity.

21 (c) A statement regarding the percentage of minority, women,  
22 veteran, and Louisiana-based ownership of the contracting entity, unless  
23 it is a publicly traded entity.

24 (d) A statement that all applicable federal, state, and payroll  
25 taxes owed by the contracting entity have been paid and are current.

26 (e) If the contracting entity is a nonprofit organization, a  
27 statement that the contracting entity has filed a current Form 990, as  
28 required by the Internal Revenue Code, along with a copy of its most  
29 recent Form 990.

30 (f) A statement indicating the type or nature of the contract with  
31 the state agency, including whether the contract was publicly bid,  
32 competitively bid, competitively negotiated, or let through a  
33 noncompetitive process; the value of the contract; and the name of each  
34 state agency which is or would be a party to the contract.

35 (g) The names and addresses of all agents, registered lobbyists,  
36 and other persons lobbying, as "lobbying" is defined in R.S. 24:51 or  
37 R.S. 49:72, on behalf of the contracting entity relative to a contract or  
38 potential contract with the state or an appropriation or grant."
