HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

2016 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Representative Norton to Engrossed House Bill No. 1035 by Representative Hodges

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 17:2115(C)" and before the comma "," insert "and (D)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 3, after "recite" and before "specified" delete "a"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, delete line 4 in its entirety and insert "passages; and to provide for related
7 matters."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 6, after "R.S. 17:2115(C)" and before "hereby" delete "is" and insert "and
10 (D) are"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 1, at the end of line 8, add a semi-colon ";" and add "other passages"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 1, after line 17, add the following:

15 "D. Each parish, city, and other local public school board shall
16 require students in grades four through six to recite, at the commencement
17 of the first class of the day, the following passage:

18 "For King, the Declaration of Independence, which he quoted directly
19 from, was a promissory note that the United States would ultimately
20 guarantee for all people "the unalienable rights of life, liberty, and the
21 pursuit of happiness." As King then said, "It is obvious that America
22 has defaulted on the promissory note." King was not calling for the
23 destruction of the American political order, but rather for us to be
24 true to the ideals of the founding, and that's why it is important that
25 he quoted the Declaration."
