

SENATE BILL NO. 112

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:563(11), (12), (13), and (14), 589(A), 590(A)(1), and
3 599(A)(2)(f) and to enact R.S. 37:563(15) through (17), 575(A)(17), and 591.1,
4 relative to the practice of cosmetology; to provide relative to mobile salons; to
5 provide relative to certain definitions, terms, procedures, requirements, effects,
6 certificates of registration, and fees; to provide for the promulgation and adoption of
7 administrative rules; and to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 37:563(11), (12), (13), and (14), 589(A), 590(A)(1), and 599(A)(2)(f)
10 are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 37:563(15) through (17), 575(A)(17), and 591.1
11 are hereby enacted to read as follows:

12 §563. Definitions

13 As used in this Chapter, the following words shall have the meaning herein
14 ascribed to them, unless the content clearly otherwise indicates:

15 * * *

16 (11) **"Mobile salon" means a self-contained facility, where cosmetology**
17 **is practiced for a fee, that may be moved, towed, or transported from one**
18 **location to another.**

19 (12) "Satellite classroom" means a separate classroom location used as
20 supplemental training space located under the same roof of the main school building
21 or on the same campus as the administrative center and ~~at least within~~ **within at least**
22 three hundred feet of the main school building for the purpose of training an
23 overflow of students who cannot be accommodated at the main school.

24 ~~(12)~~(13) "School" means any premises wherein cosmetology is taught.

25 ~~(13)~~(14) "Student" means a person registered in a school authorized by the
26 board to teach cosmetology.

27 ~~(14)~~(15) "Teacher" or "instructor" means a person who teaches cosmetology

1 for direct or indirect compensation, within a school.

2 (16) "Blow dry technician" means an individual who provides blow
3 drying hair services.

4 (17) "Blow drying hair services" means to provide to an individual for
5 compensation the services of beautifying, cleaning, arranging, curling, dressing,
6 blow drying, or performing any other similar procedure intended to beautify,
7 clean, or arrange the hair.

8 * * *

9 §575. Powers and duties of the board

10 A. The board shall be responsible for the control and regulation of the
11 practice of cosmetology and shall do all of the following:

12 * * *

13 (17)(a) Adopt rules to establish and regulate the license of blow dry
14 technician.

15 (b) An applicant for a license of blow dry technician is subject to the
16 same qualifications and fees applicable to a cosmetologist as described in R.S.
17 37:582; however, the required number of instruction hours for a cosmetologist,
18 as provided in R.S. 37:595, shall not apply.

20 §589. Certificates of registration for managers

21 A. Any cosmetology salon owner or mobile salon owner who is not a
22 licensed cosmetologist, any manicuring salon owner who is not a licensed
23 manicurist, and any esthetics salon owner who is not a licensed esthetician shall
24 employ a manager who is a licensed cosmetologist and who shall not be absent from
25 the salon more than two working days per week; however, a registered manicurist
26 may manage a manicuring salon and a registered esthetician may manage an
27 esthetics salon.

29 §590. Renewal of certificates of registration

30 A.(1) Every beauty shop owner, mobile salon owner, booth renter, manager

1 of a beauty shop, and school shall, on or before January thirty-first of each calendar
2 year, renew his or its certificate of registration. Every certificate of registration
3 which has not been timely renewed shall expire on the following first day of March,
4 at which time the holder of such certificate of registration may have his certificate
5 renewed only upon fulfilling the requirements provided for by this Chapter and
6 paying the restoration fee provided in R.S. 37:599.

8 **§591.1. Mobile salons**

9 **A.(1) Beginning June 1, 2017, the board may issue a certificate of**
10 **registration for the operation of a mobile salon to any applicant who submits an**
11 **application on a form approved by the board, pays all required fees as provided**
12 **in R.S. 37:599, and is determined to be in compliance with the provisions of this**
13 **Chapter.**

14 **(2) All requirements that apply to a beauty shop or salon either pursuant**
15 **to this Chapter or by rule shall also apply to mobile salons, except to the extent**
16 **that the requirements conflict with this Section or with any rules adopted in**
17 **accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act by the board pursuant to the**
18 **provisions of this Section.**

19 **B. By June 1, 2017, the board shall adopt rules in accordance with the**
20 **Administrative Procedure Act to implement the provisions of this Section. Such**
21 **rules shall include but are not limited to the establishment of minimum**
22 **specifications for the facilities, technical equipment, environment, supplies,**
23 **personnel, and procedures for mobile salons.**

25 §599. Fees

26 A. The following fees shall be assessed by the board:

28 (2) For each initial certificate of registration and each annual renewal of such
29 certificate:

1	(f) Beauty shop or salon <u>and mobile salon</u>	
2	(i) Resident	\$30.00
3	(ii) Nonresident	\$65.00
4	(iii) Home care	\$30.00
5	(iv) Initial inspection fee for salon, <u>mobile salon,</u> or booth rental	\$25.00

7 Section 2. The board shall adopt rules pursuant to R.S. 37:575(A)(17) as enacted by
8 Section 1 of this Act no later than June 1, 2017.
