Increases court reporter fees paid in all cases on appeal in the 34th Judicial District Court.

Purpose of Bill: This bill provides that in all cases on appeal, the court reporter will be paid a fee not to exceed \$3.00 for each page transcribed and increases from \$.25 to \$1.50 the per page fee paid by a litigant requesting a copy of the transcript. For matters not on appeal, a litigant requesting a transcript of testimony will enter into a fee-based private civil contract with the court reporter, which fee will be in accordance with fees customarily charged for depositions.
