1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Chloe Casnave of Covington High School upon her selection as a
3 representative of Louisiana at the Hugh O'Brian World Leadership Congress in
4 Chicago, Illinois.

5 WHEREAS, the Hugh O'Brian Leadership program (HOBY) was established in 1958
6 by the popular actor Hugh O'Brian following a visit to Africa where he was inspired after
7 meeting with Dr. Albert Schweitzer to create an organization designed to encourage young
8 people to take a leadership role in society and become catalysts for change; and

9 WHEREAS, Chloe Casnave attended the Louisiana Hugh O'Brian Leadership
10 Seminar held in June, 2016, in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and

11 WHEREAS, Chloe Casnave was joined in the leadership seminar by one hundred ten
12 other young leaders representing their high schools throughout Louisiana; they discussed the
13 core values of the HOBY organization, including the impact of volunteering in one's
14 community, partnership in community, and an appreciation and need for diversity in today's
15 culture; and

16 WHEREAS, the Hugh O'Brian World Leadership Congress is held every year in
17 conjunction with a major United States university, and the World Leadership Congress
18 brings together young men and women from around the world for a weeklong intensive
19 educational leadership conference; and

1 WHEREAS, Chloe Casnave was chosen as one of three high school ambassadors to
2 represent Louisiana in the Hugh O'Brian World Leadership Congress being held in July,
3 2016, at Loyola University Chicago; and

4 WHEREAS, at the World Leadership Congress, more than four hundred students
5 from around the world assemble to learn firsthand about other cultures and opinions, form
6 friendships, and exchange ideas in an environment where they can feel comfortable in open
7 discussion with their peers, learning to voice how they have shaped and formed their own
8 views about the role of leadership in society; and

9 WHEREAS, Hugh O'Brian believes the most important thing in education is to teach
10 young people to think for themselves, and the more than four hundred seventy-five thousand
11 HOBY alumni demonstrate how this belief has influenced and inspired young people to
12 become more involved in their communities; and

13 WHEREAS, the Hugh O'Brian World Leadership Congress seeks to inspire high
14 school students to excel as leaders, using friendship with others as a catalyst for their
15 learning experiences.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend and congratulate Chloe Casnave of
18 Covington High School upon her selection as a representative of Louisiana at the Hugh
19 O'Brian World Leadership Congress in Chicago, Illinois, and does hereby recognize the
20 pride and honor that this wonderful young woman brings to her family, friends, school,
21 community, and state.

23 to Chloe Casnave and the principal of Covington High School.
