ACT 213 (HB 172)

Jefferson

Existing law provides that a person who has had his probation revoked for a first technical violation shall be required to serve a sentence of not more than 90 days.

Prior law provided that this 90-day sentence shall be served without diminution of sentence or credit for time served prior to the revocation for the technical violation.

New law retains existing law providing that the 90-day sentence shall be served without diminution of sentence, but changes prior law to provide that the defendant shall be given credit for time served prior to the revocation hearing for time served in actual custody while being held for a technical violation in a local detention facility, state institution, or out-of-state institution.

Effective August 1, 2016.
