Berthelot

Existing law authorizes the state fire marshal to conduct reviews for plans or specifications of a facility licensed, certified, or seeking licensure or certification by the Dept. of Health and Hospitals (DHH). New law retains existing law.

Prior law required DHH, in consultation with the state fire marshal, to develop and adopt rules for the state fire marshal to conduct the reviews for plans or specifications as described in existing law.

New law redesignates the rulemaking authority from DHH to the state fire marshal.

New law requires the state fire marshal, in consultation with DHH, to develop and adopt rules for the state fire marshal to conduct the reviews for plans or specifications as described in existing law.

Effective August 1, 2016.
