Existing law provides for procedures for the interdiction of certain persons. In the judgment of interdiction, existing law requires the court to appoint a curator and undercurator, state when the powers of curator commence, and direct the clerk of court to record the judgment.

New law adds the requirement that judgments of interdiction include the defendant's name, domicile, age, and current address.

Effective August 1, 2016.
