Existing law provides for the operation of video draw poker devices at qualified truck stops.

Prior law required the La. Gaming Control Board to revoke the license to operate video draw poker devices for a third or subsequent violation of allowing a person under the age of 21 to play or operate a video draw poker device at a licensed establishment.

New law amends prior law to remove the automatic revocation penalty for a third or subsequent offense and provides for a hearing to be conducted by the Gaming Control Board to determine if extenuating circumstances are present pursuant to which a license suspension or revocation should not be imposed.

New law provides that at the conclusion of the hearing, the board may revoke or suspend a license or impose a fine on the licensee pursuant to existing law.

Effective August 1, 2016.
