Existing law provides a child support guideline schedule which is based on economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

New law retains existing law but incorporates the most recent economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

Prior law provided monthly basic child support obligations for combined adjusted monthly gross incomes beginning with \$0 per month.

New law amends the monthly basic child support obligations and utilizes \$0-\$900 as the minimum adjusted monthly gross income.

Prior law provided a ceiling of \$30,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

New law amends prior law by raising the ceiling from \$30,000 to \$40,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Effective August 1, 2016.
