Existing law prohibits the misrepresentation of the name, or type of any fruit, vegetable, grain, meat, or fish, including catfish, sold, or offered for sale, to any actual or prospective consumer.

New law adds the origin of certain foods and shellfish to the list of items that may not be misrepresented when being sold, or offered or exposed for sale, to any actual or prospective consumer.

Effective August 1, 2016.
