Existing law creates the La. Energy and Power Authority as a political subdivision of the state for the purpose of providing facilities for the generation and transmission of electric power and energy.

Existing law provides that the La. Energy and Power Authority is governed by a board of directors and provides for terms of the members of such board. Requires directors to be U.S. citizens domiciled in La.

Prior law required directors to be domiciled in the municipality represented. New law provides that a director shall be an employee of or domiciled in the municipality.

Effective August 1, 2016.
