<u>Existing law</u> authorizes police juries and other parish governing authorities to pass ordinances and regulations relative to the marking, sale, and destruction of cattle, horses, and mules.

<u>Prior law</u> authorized parish governing authorities to police cattle in cases not provided for by law and to fix the time in which cattle may rove.

<u>New law</u> authorizes parish governing authorities to police livestock, rather than cattle, and to fix the time in which livestock, rather than cattle, may rove.

Effective August 1, 2016.
