

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

ACT 621 (HB 14)

2016 Regular Session

Existing law establishes the following state and statewide retirement systems, plans, and funds:

- (1) La. State Employees' Retirement System
- (2) Teachers' Retirement System of La.
- (3) La. School Employees' Retirement System
- (4) State Police Retirement System
- (5) La. Assessors' Retirement Fund
- (6) Clerks of Court Retirement and Relief Fund
- (7) District Attorneys' Retirement System
- (8) Firefighters' Retirement System
- (9) Municipal Employees' Retirement System
- (10) Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
- (11) Parochial Employees' Retirement System
- (12) Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System
- (13) Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund

Prior law provided that the chairman of the House Committee on Retirement served as ex officio trustee on each such board. New law places a member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives as a trustee on each such board, instead of the chairman of the House Committee on Retirement.

Existing law for every system except the State Police Retirement System authorizes the legislative ex officio trustees to appoint designees. New law authorizes the legislative trustees to also appoint designees to serve on the State Police Retirement System board.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 17, 2016).
