ACT 445 (HB 751)

Relative to the compulsory seat belt law, prior law provided that a person who violated existing law subsequent to Aug. 31, 1995, and prior to Nov. 1, 1995, must be issued a warning ticket only.

New law removes prior law.

Prior law provided that any person who violates existing law subsequent to Oct. 31, 1995, must be subject to certain penalties.

New law retains existing law but removes the reference to the expired time period provided in prior law.

Prior law provided that upon conviction of a first offense, the fine would be \$25, including all costs of court.

New law increases the fine from \$25 to \$50.

Prior law provided that upon conviction of a second offense, the fine would be \$50, including all costs of court.

New law increases the fine from \$50 to \$75.

Prior law provided that upon conviction of a third offense and any subsequent offense, the fine would be \$50, plus all costs of court.

New law increases the fine from \$50 to \$75.

Effective August 1, 2016.
