APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 (Item #1)

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds and to make and otherwise provide for certain reductions in
3 appropriations from certain sources to be allocated to designated agencies and
4 purposes in specific amounts for the making of supplemental appropriations and
5 reductions for said agencies and purposes for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year; to provide
6 for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. A. The commissioner of administration is authorized and directed to

4 Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer
5 is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the State General Fund (Direct) the amounts
6 of any reduction in State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory
7 Dedications, or Interagency Transfers reduced as provided or recognized in this Act,
8 excluding any reductions contained in Section 1.E., and the amounts of any reductions in
9 State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues or Statutory Dedications approved
10 and certified by the Joint Legislative Committee. The state treasurer shall make such
11 transfers from each fund prior to fully funding the appropriation from the fund. Within ten
12 days after the effective date of this Act, the state treasurer shall make all transfers provided
13 in this Act. In the event that the amount of any reduction in State General Fund by Fees and
14 Self-generated Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or Interagency Transfers being transferred
15 to the State General Fund (Direct) are insufficient to fully fund the reduction made from
16 such fund source on that date following the effective date of this Act or on that date the
17 amount remaining in Fees and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or
18 Interagency Transfers is insufficient to fully fund the reductions required by this Act and the
19 appropriation remaining after the reductions in this Act, the treasurer shall notify the
20 commissioner of administration and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

21 Section 5. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
22 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
23 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
24 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
25 effective on the day following such approval.
