RETIREMENT/BDS - COMMISSIONS: Provides relative to representation of the House of Representatives on the boards of trustees of state and statewide retirement systems

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:181(A)(introductory paragraph), (B)(introductory paragraph),
3	and (E), 186(A) and (C), 511(1), 822(A)(5), 1162(A)(2), 1302(A)(6), 1471(A)(3),
4	1541(A)(8), 1651(B)(1)(a), 1821(B)(5), 1981(B)(4), 2091(B)(1), 2173(A)(7),
5	2225(A)(2)(a), and 2260(A)(2)(d)(i), relative to the boards of trustees of the state and
6	statewide retirement systems; to provide for the chairman of the House Committee
7	on Retirement to serve as trustee of the state and statewide retirement systems; to
8	provide relative to legislative staff's attendance at executive sessions of the boards
9	of trustees of the state and statewide retirement systems; and to provide for related
10	matters.

A. As ex officio members of each of the state and statewide retirement system boards, the The chairman of the House Committee on Retirement and the chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement may each independently authorize legislative staff to attend any executive session of any board meeting or committee meeting of any state or statewide retirement system board or committee.

C. Legislative staff authorized to attend executive session pursuant to this Section Any information or communication which, pursuant to the provisions of this Section, is provided to or presented in the presence of authorized staff shall be subject to have the same rights, duties, and privileges, including the lawyer-client privilege, which apply to the chairmen as members of the board, including the attorney-client privilege. as they relate to any information or communication that is provided to or presented in the presence of such legislative staff in executive session.

Abstract: Changes House Committee on Retirement membership on the state and statewide retirement systems from a committee member appointed by the speaker to the chairman of the committee - effective on adjournment sine die of the 2020 R.S.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the following state and statewide retirement systems and funds:

<u>Present law</u> further provides that a member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives serves as trustee on the board of trustees of each of the state and statewide retirement systems and funds. <u>Proposed law</u> removes the member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the Speaker as trustee of each board and instead places the chairman of the House Committee on Retirement as an ex officio member of each such board.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the chairmen of the House Committee on Retirement and the Senate Committee on Retirement, as ex officio members of the state and statewide retirement system boards, may authorize legislative staff to attend executive sessions of any board or committee meeting of the state or statewide retirement systems. <u>Proposed law</u> removes language specifying that this authority of the chairmen is exercised in their capacity as ex officio members of the state and statewide retirement system boards.
