





Proposed law provides that an entering kindergartner who meets any of the following criteria is eligible to participate in the program:

- (1) Would otherwise attend a public school with a letter grade of a "C", "D", or "F".
- (2) Is the sibling of a scholarship recipient who is currently enrolled in and who will be attending the same participating school in which the student is enrolling in kindergarten.

Present law provides that each local school system or the Recovery School District shall conduct its annual kindergarten enrollment process and shall report such enrollment to the department prior to the program enrollment process.

Proposed law deletes present law.

Present law provides that a scholarship recipient is a member of the local school system in which he attended or otherwise would be attending and requires students entering kindergarten to enroll in the local school system in which they would otherwise be attending public school.

Proposed law deletes present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
