DISTRICTS/HOSPITAL SERVC: Provides relative to the per diem paid to board members of Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 46:1053(C)(2)(h), relative to Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry
3 Parish; to provide relative to the per diem paid to members of the governing board
4 of the district; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 46:1053(C)(2)(h) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §1053. Commission; qualification of members; appointment; vacancies;
11 compensation; removal of commissioners; certain powers

17 (h) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
18 governing authority of St. Landry Parish may permit a per diem to each member of
19 the commission of Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry Parish in an amount
20 of not less than forty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each day of

1 attendance at meetings of the commission, not to exceed twelve meetings per year,
2 payable out of the funds of the hospital service district.

Abstract: Increases the minimum and maximum amounts of per diem that the governing authority of St. Landry Parish is authorized to pay to members of the governing board of Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry Parish.

Present law authorizes parishes to create hospital service districts. Provides that such districts shall be governed by a board of commissioners. Authorizes the governing authority of the parish in which the district is located to pay per diem to each member of the commission for attendance at meetings of the commission.

Present law provides that per diem may be paid in an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$40 per meeting for up to 12 meetings per year. Provides further that per diem is payable out of the funds of the hospital service district.

Proposed law increases the minimum and maximum per diem that the governing authority of St. Landry Parish may pay members of the governing board of Hospital Service District No. 1 of St. Landry Parish to not less than \$40 nor more than \$100.
