CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: Adds certain substances to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(57) through (59), (D)(5), (Schedule II)(B)(29), and  
3 (Schedule V)(D)(4), relative to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law;  
4 to add certain substances to Schedules I, II, and V; and to provide for related  
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(57) through (59), (D)(5), (Schedule  
8 II)(B)(29), and (Schedule V)(D)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §964. Composition of schedules

10 Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V shall, unless and until added to pursuant to R.S.  
11 40:962, consist of the following drugs or other substances, by whatever official  
12 name, common or usual name, chemical name, or brand name designated:

13 SCHEDULE I

14 A. Opiates. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule,  
15 any of the following opiates, including their isomers, esters, ethers, salts, or salts of  
16 isomers, esters, and ethers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers,  
17 or salts is possible within the specific chemical designation:

1 any quantity of the following substances having a depressant effect on the central  
2 nervous system, including its salts:

4 (4) Brivaracetam (2-[2-oxo-4-propylpyrrolidin-1-yl]butanamide), also  
5 referred to as BRV; UCB-34714; Briviact.

**Abstract:** Adds certain substances to Schedules I, II, and V of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

Present law provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law adds U-47700, Furanylfentanyl, Acrylfentanyl, and Etizolam to Schedule I.

Proposed law adds Thiafentanil to Schedule II.

Proposed law adds Brivaracetam to Schedule V.
