**Abstract:** Authorizes levee districts created after January 1, 2006, to levy up to a five-mill tax without a vote of the people.

<u>Present constitution</u> authorizes levee districts created prior to Jan. 1, 2006, to levy a property tax of up to five mills, except that the Orleans Levee District may only levy up to a two and one-half mill tax.

<u>Present constitution</u> authorizes levee districts created after Jan. 1, 2006, to levy a property tax only if approved by a majority of electors of the district. Further, <u>present constitution</u> requires that if the district is comprised of more than one parish, the tax must be approved by a majority of electors in each parish.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> changes <u>present constitution</u> by authorizing any levee district created after Jan. 1, 2006, to levy a property tax of up to five mills without a vote of the people just as those districts created prior to Jan. 1, 2006, are authorized to do in the <u>present constitution</u>.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on Oct. 14, 2017.
