19	in an amount not to exceed sixty-three one hundred dollars based upon his ability to

Abstract: Increases the maximum amount of the monthly fee for parole supervision.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the committee on parole to impose certain conditions or requirements on a person who is released on parole including the requirement that the person pay a fee to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections in an amount not to exceed \$63, based upon the offender's ability to pay as determined by the committee on parole.

Proposed law increases the maximum amount of the fee from \$63 to \$100.
