TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION: (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes a parish local option concerning the amount of assessed value at which the homestead exemption shall apply

A JOINT RESOLUTION

2	Proposing to add Article VII, Section 20(A)(11) of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative
3	to the homestead exemption for ad valorem tax; to authorize a parish governing
4	authority to change the amount of assessed value at which the homestead exemption
5	shall apply subject to limitations; to require approval by the electors; to provide for
6	an effective date; to provide for submission of the proposed amendment to the
7	electors; and to provide for related matters.
8	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
9	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
10	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add
11	Article VII, Section 20(A)(11) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
12	§20. Homestead Exemption
13	Section 20.(A) Homeowners.
14	* * *
15	(11) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section to the contrary, a
16	parish governing authority may provide by resolution or ordinance for the amount
17	of assessed value at which the homestead exemption shall apply for purposes of
18	those ad valorem taxes imposed in the parish to which the homestead exemption
19	applies; however, in no case shall the amount of assessed valuation so established

1 exceed two thousand dollars. The resolution or ordinance shall only become 2 effective after it is approved by a majority of the electors in the parish voting thereon 3 in an election held for that purpose. 4 5 Section 2. Be it further resolved that the provisions of the amendment contained in 6 this Joint Resolution shall become effective on January 1, 2018. 7 Section 3. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted 8 to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on October 14, 9 2017. 10 Section 4. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election, 11 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted 12 to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as 13 follows: 14 Do you support an amendment to authorize a parish governing authority, 15 subject to voter approval, to establish the amount of a property's assessed 16 value at which the homestead exemption shall apply, not to exceed two 17 thousand dollars? (Effective January 1, 2018) (Adds Article VII, Section 18 20(A)(11))

**Abstract:** Authorizes a parish governing authority, subject to voter approval, to establish the amount of assessed valuation at which the homestead exemption shall apply in that parish.

<u>Present constitution</u> exempts from certain property taxes the first \$7,500 of assessed valuation (\$75,000 of fair market value) of a homestead.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains provisions of <u>present constitution</u> with respect to the \$7,500 homestead exemption and authorizes a parish governing authority by resolution or ordinance to establish an assessed value at which the homestead exemption shall apply in that parish, subject to voter approval. Further, the assessed value established as authorized under <u>proposed constitutional amendment</u> shall not exceed \$2,000 (\$20,000 of fair market value).

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 14, 2017.

Effective Jan. 1, 2018.
