Abstract: Prohibits insurers from combining a higher classified fire protection area with a lower classified fire protection area for the determination of fire insurance rates for the combined areas.

<u>Present law</u> requires insurance companies writing fire insurance in La. to adhere to rates promulgated by the Property Insurance Association of Louisiana (PIAL).

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits insurance companies writing fire insurance in La. from combining a lower classified fire protection area with a higher classified fire protection area for the determination of fire insurance rates for the combined areas.
