**Abstract:** Requires the operator of certain motor vehicles drive at least ten miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit on all interstate highways.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits a person from operating a vehicle on any highway of the state in excess of 55 miles per hour unless a lower maximum speed is posted on the highway and provides for exceptions to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a requirement that a person operating a school bus, truck-tractor, trailer, semi-trailer, or any combination of these vehicles drive at least 10 miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit when traveling on any interstate highway.
