HB 465 Original 2017 Regular Session Steve Carter
Abstract: Requires the operator of certain motor vehicles drive at least ten miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit on all interstate highways.

Present law prohibits a person from operating a vehicle on any highway of the state in excess of 55 miles per hour unless a lower maximum speed is posted on the highway and provides for exceptions to present law.

Proposed law retains present law and adds a requirement that a person operating a school bus, trucktractor, trailer, semi-trailer, or any combination of these vehicles drive at least 10 miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit when traveling on any interstate highway.
