MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for an additional fee on driver's license applications to benefit the Military Family Assistance Fund

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I),
3	(ee), (ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), and (ee) and R.S. 46:122(A)(1), relative to driver's license
4	fees; to provide for a one dollar increase in driver's license fees to benefit the
5	Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (cc), (dd)(I), (ee),
8	(ii)(aa), (cc), (dd)(l), and (ee) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation;
10	disabled veteran designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation;
11	disbursement of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D"
12	or "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception
13	A.(1) Every applicant for a Class "D" driver's license, or for a renewal of a
14	Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New
15	Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of forty-two forty-three dollars and
16	seventy-five cents. Eleven dollars and fifteen cents of the fee shall be paid to the
17	Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee
18	shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account
19	which is created with the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S.

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56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(2) The fee for Class "D" driver's licenses, or renewal of a Class "D" driver's 3 4 license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be fifty-four fifty-five dollars, fifteen dollars of which shall be payable by the department to the 5 6 board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar 7 and eighty-four cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement 8 System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the 9 department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the 10 Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the 11 fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

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(5) Every applicant for a Class "E" driver's license, or for a renewal of a 13 14 Class "E" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New 15 Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty twenty-one dollars and 16 twenty-five cents, which shall be the cost of such basic license. Five dollars and 17 sixty-three cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement 18 System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the 19 department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the 20 Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the 21 fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

22 (6) The fee for a Class "E" driver's license, or renewal of a Class "E" driver's 23 license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be twenty 24 twenty-one dollars and twenty-five cents, three dollars and seventy-five cents of 25 which fee shall be paid by the department to the board of trustees of the police 26 pension funds of the city of New Orleans. Three dollars and seventy-five cents of 27 the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One 28 dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter 29 abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund

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1	through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the
2	Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

4	B.(1) Every applicant for a Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's
5	license, or for a renewal of a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's
6	license, except for those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for
7	such basic license a fee of sixty-one sixty-two dollars and fifty cents. Sixteen dollars
8	and twenty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement
9	System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the
10	department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the
11	Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the
12	fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.
13	(2) The fee for a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
14	or for the renewal of a basic Class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license,
15	issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be seventy-six
16	seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents, fifteen dollars of which fee shall be paid by the
17	department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New
18	Orleans. Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police
19	Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by
20	the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created with
21	the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of
22	the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

26	(e)(i)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E"
27	driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, except those bona
28	fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of six
29	seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The

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license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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(cc) Seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the office of state police.
Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State
Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be
forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is
created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).
One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

(dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-two twenty-three dollars and thirteen cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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(ee) Five dollars and fifty-six cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana
State Police Pension and Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the
fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education
account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of
R.S. 56:10(B)(15). <u>One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military</u>
Family Assistance Fund.

(ii)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E" driver's
license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide
residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of six
<u>seven</u> dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This
license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is

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nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

4 (cc) One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be paid to the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar and fifty 5 6 cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and Retirement Fund. One 7 dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter 8 abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund 9 through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the fee shall be paid to the 10 Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.

11 (dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's 12 license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-13 14 seven twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the 15 license. This license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant 16 which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, 17 unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

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19 (ee) Seven dollars and fifty cents of the fee shall be payable by the 20 department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New 21 Orleans. Ninety-two cents of the fee shall be paid to the State Police Pension and 22 Retirement Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the 23 department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the 24 Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15). One dollar of the 25 fee shall be paid to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund. * * 26

27 Section 2. R.S. 46:122(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 28

§122. Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund

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1	A.(1) Funds received by the state treasurer pursuant to the provisions of $R.S.$
2	47:120.31 and 306.3, or received by the treasurer or the Louisiana Military Family
3	Assistance Board from other public or private donations, gifts, grants, appropriations
4	or other revenue, including revenue derived from driver's license fees, shall be
5	deposited and credited to a special fund hereby created in the state treasury to be
6	known as the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund. The money in the fund
7	shall be used solely as provided for in Subsection B of this Section. In addition to
8	funds from any other source, public or private donations, gifts, or grants from
9	individuals, corporations, nonprofit organizations, or other business entities may be
10	made to the fund and accepted by the fund for military family relief and assistance
11	as provided in this Part.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "D" driver's license fee from \$42.75 to \$43.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund (fund).

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "D" driver's license fee of \$54.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "D" driver's license fee from \$54.00 to \$55.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

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<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "E" driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$20.25 to \$21.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "E" driver's license fee from \$20.25 to \$21.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$61.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$61.50 to \$62.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$76.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$76.50 to \$77.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older a class "D" driver's license fee of \$22.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "D" driver's license from \$22.13 to \$23.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "E" driver's license from 6.75 ± 7.75 . Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional 1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "D" driver's license fee of \$27.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "D" driver's license from \$27.75 to \$28.75. Proposed law further provides for the distribution of the additional \$1.00 to the fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for funds received pursuant to <u>present law</u> to be deposited to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the revenue derived from <u>proposed law</u> to the funds deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.
