HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Provides for legislative approval prior to the removal of monuments by local or political subdivisions. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Chapter 8-A of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised
3	of R.S. 25:528 and 528.1, relative to historical monuments and memorials; to provide
4	for the protection of monuments and memorials; to require legislative approval prior
5	to removal of monuments; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Chapter 8-A of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
8	comprised of R.S. 25:528 and 528.1, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	CHAPTER 8-A. HISTORICAL LINGUISTIC AND CULTURAL
10	ORIGINS PROTECTION ACT
11	§528. Purpose; legislative intent; short title
12	A. Article XII, Sec. 4, of the Constitution of Louisiana guarantees "(t)he
13	right of people to preserve, foster, and promote their respective historical
14	linguistic and cultural origins".
15	B.(1) In furtherance of the rights declared in the Constitution of
16	Louisiana, it is the intention of the legislature to protect all aspects of our state
17	history as an educational tool to promote our past achievements and learn from

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1	our past mistakes.
2	(2) In furtherance of the legislature's intent, this Chapter shall be known
3	as the "Historical Linguistic and Cultural Origins Protection Act".
4	§528.1. Protections; prohibitions, approval of the legislature
5	A. No item listed in Subsection B of this Section, which is displayed on
6	public property of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, shall be
7	relocated, removed, disturbed, or altered unless such action has received prior
8	approval by a concurrent resolution of the legislature.
9	B. Those items which are subject to this Chapter include all of the
10	<u>following:</u>
11	(a) Any museum, scientific, or cultural facility provided for in Title 25
12	of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.
13	(b) Any monument, memorial, or plaque which has been in existence for
14	at least twenty-five years.
15	(c) Any landmark listed on the National Register of Historical Places.
16	(d) Any landmark listed on any historical registry which has received
17	any state or federal funds.
18	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
19	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
20	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
21	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
22	effective on the day following such approval.

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<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it is the intention of the legislature to preserve the historical educational tools of our state in furtherance of the rights declared in the Louisiana Constitution.

Proposed law provides that the following items must have approval by the legislature prior to being relocated, removed, disturbed, or altered:

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- (1) Any museum, scientific or cultural facility provided for in Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.
- (2) Any monument, memorial, or plaque which has been in existence for at least twenty-five years.
- (3) Any landmark listed on the National Register of Historical Places.
- (4) Any landmark listed on any historical registry which has received any state or federal funds.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
