DISTRICT ATTORNEYS. Provides relative to health insurance for certain retired district attorneys. (8/1/17)

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AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 16:516(A), relative to district attorneys; to provide for the payment of group health insurance premiums for certain retired district attorneys; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 16:516(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§516. Health insurance; retired district attorneys; certain judicial districts

A. The premium costs of group health insurance shall be paid in full from the district attorney's general fund, in and for the Fifth, Seventh, Eighteenth, Twenty-First, Twenty-Third, Twenty-Fifth, ~~Twenty-Ninth~~, Thirtieth, and Fortieth judicial districts as may be applicable, for any district attorney who retired with at least twenty-five years of full-time service regardless of age.

Present law provides that the premium costs of group health insurance shall be paid in full from the district attorney's general fund for any district attorney who retired with at least 25 years of full-time service regardless of age from the 5th, 7th, 18th, 21st, 23rd, 25th, 29th, 30th, or 40th judicial district.

Proposed law removes the 29th judicial district and otherwise retains present law.

Effective August 1, 2017.
