1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Wednesday, April 12, 2017, as Y Day in Louisiana and to commend Louisiana
3 YMCAs for dedication to families in the state.

4 WHEREAS, Louisiana YMCAs are committed to nurturing the potential of children,
5 promoting healthy living, and fostering a sense of social responsibility; and

6 WHEREAS, the YMCA's core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility
7 unite its leaders and staff as a movement and guide their behavior, interactions with each
8 other, and decisionmaking; and

9 WHEREAS, more than one hundred thousand children and adults, throughout
10 Louisiana, have access, through local YMCAs, to the essentials necessary to learn, grow, and
11 thrive; and

12 WHEREAS, Louisiana's Ys support the development of integrated, community-based
13 strategies for serving children and families; and

14 WHEREAS, Louisiana's Ys stand ready to support state government efforts to
15 provide developmental programs for youth, strengthen families, and mobilize and coordinate
16 broad efforts to support children and families through partnerships that meet community
17 needs; and

18 WHEREAS, on April 12, 2017, representatives of Louisiana's Ys are meeting with
19 legislators at the state capitol to discuss and exchange ideas on issues facing youth and
20 families.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
2 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Wednesday, April 12, 2017, as Y Day in
3 Louisiana and does hereby commend the members and volunteers of Louisiana's YMCAs
4 for their dedication to families throughout the state.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
6 to the chairman of the Louisiana Statewide Alliance of YMCAs.
