5 investigator for scientific information; internationally, he is ranked in the top one percent of

6 cited scientists; and

7 WHEREAS, Dr. Granger has over 600 peer reviewed publications in many

8 international journals; and

9 WHEREAS, since 1987, he has served as a professor and chairman of the

10 Department of Molecular and Cellular Physiology at the LSU Health Sciences Center in

11 Shreveport; and

12 WHEREAS, in recognition of his highly dedicated service to the LSU Health

13 Sciences Center in Shreveport, he was awarded more than twenty-five million dollars in

14 federal research money; and

15 WHEREAS, he has served as president of the Microcirculatory Society and the

16 American Physiological Society; and

17 WHEREAS, Dr. Granger has demonstrated a lifelong commitment to his ambitious

18 work; he has received international awards from the British Microcirculation Society, the

19 Japanese Microcirculation Society, and the World Congress for Microcirculation; and

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Granger has been recognized internationally for his extensive
2 knowledge and findings in the field of microvascular dysfunction associated with acute and
3 chronic inflammation; and

4 WHEREAS, during his successful career at the LSU Health Sciences Center in
5 Shreveport, Dr. Granger has been instrumental in the growth and excellence of its academic
6 mission, and his international recognitions have brought distinction to the LSU Health
7 Sciences Center at Shreveport.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9 commend D. Neil Granger, Ph.D., for his many accomplishments and contributions to the
10 LSU Health Sciences Center in Shreveport; does hereby recognize and record for posterity
11 his exemplary leadership; and does hereby extend to him best wishes for continued success
12 throughout his career.
