2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:3415.10(D), relative to appraisal management company  
3 license applications and renewals; to change a sunset provision; and to provide for

6 Section 1. R.S. 37:3415.10(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §3415.10. License application assessment; delinquent renewal

9 D. The provisions of this Section shall expire on December 31, ~~2017~~ 2019.

**Abstract:** Changes the sunset date for the collection of initial and renewal license assessments.

Present law imposes an expiration date on certain application procedures relative to applicants for licenses or licensees applying for a renewal of their appraisal management company licenses. Proposed law retains the portion of present law imposing the sunset provision but changes the sunset date from Dec. 31, 2017, to Dec. 31, 2019.
