COMMENDATIONS. Commends the LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans School of Dentistry's Summer Enrichment Program.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend the Summer Enrichment Program at the Louisiana State University (LSU)
3	Health Sciences Center New Orleans School of Dentistry.
4	WHEREAS, LSU Health Sciences Center's School of Dentistry has undertaken a
5	mission to increase the number of Under-Represented Minority (URM) and Disadvantaged
6	students applying to and being accepted to their undergraduate and graduate level dentistry
7	programs; and
8	WHEREAS, LSU Health Sciences Center has a mission to provide community
9	outreach throughout Louisiana; and
10	WHEREAS, the LSU Health Sciences Center School of Dentistry is the only dental
11	school in Louisiana; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2008, the School of Dentistry began the Summer Enrichment
13	Program, which provides a two-week summer course that introduces undergraduate students
14	to areas of dental clinical practice, the application process for dental school, and the
15	requirements for various dental school programs; and
16	WHEREAS, since inception, the program has introduced one hundred young adults
17	to dental healthcare professional opportunities, of which 99% were Under-Represented
18	Minority individuals and 73% were Under-Represented females; and

WHEREAS, the program is provided at no cost to all participants thanks to donations
from private corporations, state associations, and the School of Dentistry; and
WHEREAS, current School of Dentistry students participate in the Summer
Enrichment Program providing mentoring opportunities and program support; and
WHEREAS, the Summer Enrichment Program is meeting its goal of exposing
Under-Represented Minority students to dentistry healthcare and the LSU Health Sciences
Center's School of Dentistry.
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
does hereby commend the Summer Enrichment Program at the LSU Health Sciences Center
New Orleans School of Dentistry, as well as the faculty, staff, and students who support the
program, for their outreach to Under-Represented Minority and Disadvantaged students and
the program's ongoing goal of increasing awareness and participation in dental healthcare
to all areas of the Louisiana population.
