AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:463.60(B), relative to special prestige license plates; to
3	provide with respect to the "Animal Friendly" prestige license plate; to provide for
4	an increase of the annual royalty fee; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.60(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§463.60. Special prestige license plates; "Animal Friendly" prestige license plate;
9	animal population control; Pet Overpopulation Fund
10	* * *
11	B. The annual fee for this prestige license plate shall be a royalty fee of
12	twenty-five thirty-five dollars to be distributed as provided in this Section and a
13	handling fee of three dollars and fifty cents to be retained by the department to offset
14	a portion of administrative costs. These charges shall be in addition to the standard
15	motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of
16	Louisiana.

<u>Present law</u> provides for special prestige license plates for automobiles, including the "Animal Friendly" prestige license plate.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a \$25 annual royalty fee and distributes the avails of the royalty fee each quarter to the Pet Overpopulation Advisory Council.

Proposed law increases the annual royalty fee to \$35.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
