3 WHEREAS, since its inception, the Human Development Center has provided direct
4 services to more than twenty-three thousand individuals, more than one hundred twenty
5 thousand instances of technical assistance and community training to professionals in health
6 and education fields, and long-term interdisciplinary and leadership training to more than
7 two hundred professionals in health and education fields.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
9 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Human Development Center of the LSU
10 Health Sciences Center New Orleans' School of Allied Health Professions for advancing
11 education, training, and direct services in support of Louisiana's population with disabilities
12 and their families.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that suitable copies of this Resolution be transmitted
14 to the director of the Human Development Center, and to the dean of the LSU Health
15 Sciences Center New Orleans' School of Allied Health Professions.
