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Authorizes the disclosure of autopsy-related documents to the Department of Children and Family Services at no charge

Under <u>present law</u>, appropriate law enforcement agencies can request copies of an autopsy report, records, writings, and documents from coroner offices free of charge. <u>Proposed law</u> adds the Dept. of Children and Family Services (DCFS) as an agency that may receive coroner's autopsy report, records, writings, and documents, if requested, free of charge.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation is anticipated to decrease expenditures by an indeterminable, but nominal amount within the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) as a result of now requiring coroners to provide copies of autopsy reports to the department free of charge. Presently, if DCFS requests copies of autopsy reports, the department must reimburse coroners according to the Uniform Fee Schedule for public records.

Historically, DCFS receives an average of 68 autopsy reports annually. The department has indicated that an autopsy report from Orleans parish averages \$75. For <u>illustrative purposes</u>, if DCFS requested 68 autopsy reports from coroners at a cost of \$75 per report, DCFS would have cost savings of \$5,100 (\$75 x 68 autopsy reports) under this proposed legislation.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation is anticipated to decrease revenues by an indeterminable, but minimal, amount to parish coroner's offices as a result of requiring coroners to provide copies of autopsy reports to the Department of Children and Family Services free of charge.
