SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates Monday, April 24, 2017, as Tourism Day at the state capitol

A RESOLUTION

2	To designate Monday, April 24, 2017, as Tourism Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, 2016 was a record-breaking year for tourism in this state with more than
4	46.7 million people visiting Louisiana and spending a total of \$16.8 billion; and
5	WHEREAS, 2016 visitor expenditures resulted in \$1.04 billion in state tax revenue;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, the revenue generated from domestic and international visitors
8	represents a remarkable 40-to-1 return on investment of state funding of the Louisiana office
9	of tourism; and
10	WHEREAS, tourism employment ranked fourth in the number of jobs created in
11	2016, and travel spending supports 231,567 jobs in Louisiana; and
12	WHEREAS, no state general funds are appropriated for tourism; tourism is funded
13	exclusively by a dedication of three one-hundredths of a cent of sales tax; and
14	WHEREAS, the funds generated by this dedication have been and continue to be
15	used by the Louisiana office of tourism to promote tourism to our state, and as a result they
16	create enormous economic impact; and
17	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Travel Promotion Association board of directors, on
18	behalf of the more than seven hundred fifty tourism professional members of the association,
19	recommends that the Louisiana office of tourism be able to use the full Louisiana Tourism
20	Promotion District budget as statutorily intended for advertising and marketing.
