**Abstract:** Provides for a certain number of employees for the office of Clerk of the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court.

Present law provides that the amount of money paid by the city of New Orleans to the office of the Clerk of the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court for expenses, including the salaries and maintenance of constitutional officers, their deputies, subordinates, and employees, must adequately fund the office of the Clerk of the Criminal District Court for Orleans Parish.

Present law further provides that the legislature finds funding necessary for the efficient performance of the powers and duties required of a judicial officer of the state and prohibits reduction of these amounts by the city without the consent of the legislature.

Proposed law retains present law but specifies the exact number of employees (90½) that the city of New Orleans shall appropriate funding for and pay to the office of Clerk of the Orleans Parish Criminal District Court.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action

(Amends R.S. 13:1381.7(A))
