16	"C. The provisions of this Section shall only apply:
17	(1) In any parish with a population greater than thirty-nine thousand
18	and less than forty-one thousand, according to the latest federal decennial
19	census.
20	(2) To physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, and physician
21	assistants who are enrolled as providers in the Louisiana Medicaid program and
22	the services they provide are otherwise reimbursable as Medicaid covered
23	services.
24	(3) If it can be implemented through the use of federal Medicaid
25	matching funds.
26	D. The legislature finds and declares that the intent of this Section is to
27	provide for a minimum Medicaid reimbursement amount paid for otherwise
28	eligible Medicaid services to health care providers in certain parishes.
29	E. The Louisiana Department of Health shall submit a written report to
30	the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget no later than October 1, 2017,
31	to include identification of all necessary actions required to implement the
32	provisions of this Section and a timeline for such implementation."
