SUCCESSIONS: Provides relative to the release of certain account information for the estate of a decedent

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 51:703(K), relative to the disclosure of certain account information; to provide
3	for the release of certain account information of a decedent by a dealer; to provide
4	for certain required documents; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 51:703(K) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§703. Registration of dealers, salesmen, and investment advisers and investment
8	adviser representatives; surety bonds; records; disclosures
9	* * *
10	K. A dealer or any affiliate may release account information of a decedent
11	to any representative or attorney for the estate of the decedent when the dealer or
12	affiliate receives written notice of the customer's death and satisfactory evidence of
13	that person's authority to represent the estate of the decedent. Satisfactory evidence
14	may include an affidavit executed by the person attesting to such relationship with
15	the decedent.

Abstract: Authorizes the disclosure of certain account information of a decedent by a dealer to any representative of the decedent's estate upon sufficient proof of the death of the decedent and the relationship with the decedent.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the disclosure of certain account information of a decedent by a dealer to a representative of, or attorney for, the decedent's estate upon sufficient proof of the death of the decedent and the relationship with the decedent.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the dealer receive written notice of the customer's death and evidence of the person's authority to represent the decedent.

- 1. Make technical changes.
