The proposed legislation increases Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$566,250 in FY 18 and in future fiscal years within Office of Public Health (OPH). The proposed legislation authorizes an increase of existing sewage fees as follows: (1) onetime fee for individual-type sewerage system installed for residential use from \$100 to \$150; (2) annual fee for sewerage installer license from \$100 to \$150; (3) annual fee for sewerage maintenance license from \$100 to \$150; (4) annual fee for combination installer and maintenance license from \$100 to \$150; and (5) sewerage treatment and interrelated systems inspection fee from \$100 to \$150.
