WHEREAS, the daughter of Jamie Andrews of Gonzales, Mackenzie Kay Andrews 7 attends East Ascension High School; and 8 WHEREAS, at East Ascension High, Mackenzie has participated in many extra 9 curricular activities including: the National Honor Society (reporter), President of the Beta 10 Club and Thespian Club, Captain of Yell Leader, Senior Mentor, Parliamentarian of the 11 Student Council, Chairman of Linking Lives, a member of Advanced Choir and lettered in both varsity volleyball and softball; and 12 13 WHEREAS, over the course of her high school career, Mackenzie has received many awards and honors including being named Homecoming Queen for the 2016 football year, 14 being selected as an Elks Most Valuable Student State Finalist and a Red Hot Counselor at 15 Broyhill Leadership Conference, placing first in the Capital Area Human Services PSA 16 17 contest and in the VFW's Voice of Democracy essay contest, and twice being named the 18 state champion of the Louisiana Beta Club Group Talent competition; and

1	WHEREAS, Mackenzie also starred and directed many play productions at her high
2	school including The Help, Cinderella, Hairspray, and The Lion King; and
3	WHEREAS, in her local community, Mackenzie found a way to give back using the
4	skills she learned in participating in numerous extracurricular activities at East Ascension
5	High, volunteering on projects with Habitat for Humanity, tutoring of peers, participating
6	in canned food drives, assisting in the financing of a school building in Uganda, and
7	volunteering throughout the local community in relief efforts during the recent historic flood
8	of 2016; and
9	WHEREAS, despite being involved with these activities and many others, Mackenzie
10	is currently ranked second in her senior class with a grade point average of 4.667 and has
11	been awarded the title of Student of the Year; and
12	WHEREAS, Mackenzie will be attending Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge,
13	in the fall of 2017, having earned twenty-seven hours of college credit through the dual
14	enrollment and Advanced Placement courses and plans to major in performing arts with the
15	career goal of being a working actress; and

17	Women of Excellence Awards to recognize and honor extraordinary women of excellence
18	across the state for their outstanding achievements and contributions; and
