10	his decision to serve his country; and
11	WHEREAS, he was promoted to Sergeant once his superior officers recognized his
12	unique leadership talents and his willingness to carry out all missions he and his troops were
13	given; and
14	WHEREAS, in 2013, Sergeant Voisin and his soldiers received deployment orders
15	for Afghanistan, and he and his unit, the 1084th Transportation Company, were soon serving
16	in the combat theater performing the dangerous job of providing the transportation needs of
17	his combat Brigade across the Afghan countryside; and
18	WHEREAS, Sergeant Voisin busied himself with the welfare of his troops and
