SB 60 Reengrossed DIGEST Walsworth  
2017 Regular Session

Designates a portion of US 425 in Franklin Parish as the "Trooper Bobby Smith 'Vision of Courage' Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.

Designates a portion of US 165 in Ouachita Parish as the "Sterlington Police Officer David Elahi Memorial Highway".

Directs DOTD to erect and maintain signs of these designations, provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for the material, fabrication cost, mounting posts, and installation required for installation of each sign, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Effective August 1, 2017.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the original bill

1. Changes US 425 designation to "Trooper Bobby Smith 'Vision of Courage' Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.
2. Changes US 165 designation to "Sterlington Police Officer David Elahi Memorial Highway".
3. Adds that local or private monies are required to be received by the department to fabricate and install the signs.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Provides that local or private funds received by DOTD to fabricate and install the signs must be equal to the department's actual costs, not to exceed \$550 per sign.
