Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 58 by Senator Mills

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 28 and 29 in their entirety

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 3, at the beginning of line 1, change "~~(1.1)~~" to "(1)"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 6, after line 18, delete the remainder of the page and delete page 7 in its entirety and
7 on page 8 delete lines 1 through 3 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

8 ~~"A.(1) For districts created pursuant to R.S. 28:912(B)(2), each district shall~~
9 ~~be governed by a board whose membership consists of residents of the respective~~
10 ~~regions. The number of members on the board shall consist of one representative~~
11 ~~from each parish in the region who is appointed by the local governmental authority.~~
12 ~~The membership shall also include three appointees by the governor.~~

13 ~~(2) The parish appointees shall be persons with professional experience or~~
14 ~~parents, consumers, or advocates in the fields of addictive disorders, developmental~~
15 ~~disabilities, mental health, or public health.~~

16 ~~(3) The governor's three appointees shall be one member with experience in~~
17 ~~the financial operation of a business enterprise, one member who is a parent,~~
18 ~~consumer, or caregiver of a consumer of services, and one member who represents~~
19 ~~one of the following fields: addictive disorders, developmental disabilities, mental~~
20 ~~health, or public health. The governing authority of each parish may submit three~~
21 ~~names to the governor for consideration as one of the governor's three appointees.~~

22 ~~B. The initial terms of office for board members from the first two parishes~~
23 ~~alphabetically shall be one year. The initial terms for board members from the~~
24 ~~second two parishes alphabetically shall be two years. The initial terms for all other~~
25 ~~board members shall be three years. All subsequent appointees shall serve terms of~~
26 ~~three years. No board member shall serve more than two three-year terms."~~

27 AMENDMENT NO. 4

28 On page 8, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

29 **"A. The Acadiana Area Human Services District shall be governed by**
30 **a board of ten members who are residents of the seven parishes within the**
31 **statutory governance area of the district. Seven members shall consist of one**
32 **representative from each parish within the statutory governance area of the**
33 **district who is appointed by the local governmental authority of the parish and**
34 **three members shall be appointed by the governor as follows:**

35 **(1) One member with professional expertise in the field of mental health.**

36 **(2) One member with professional expertise in the field of addictive**
37 **disorders.**

38 **(3) One member with professional expertise in the field of**
39 **developmental disabilities.**

40 **(4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,**
41 **business enterprise, or auditing.**

42 **(5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis**
43 **on specialty courts.**

1 (6) Two members who represent law enforcement, school-based health
 2 care, public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the respective
 3 appointing parishes.

4 (7) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 5 mental health appointed by the governor.

6 (8) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 7 addictive disorders appointed by the governor.

8 (9) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 9 developmental disabilities appointed by the governor.

10 B. The Imperial Calcasieu Human Services Authority shall be governed
 11 by a board of eight members who are residents of the five parishes within the
 12 statutory governance area of the authority. Five members shall consist of one
 13 representative from each parish within the statutory governance area of the
 14 authority who is appointed by the local governmental authority of the parish
 15 and three members shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

16 (1) One member with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

17 (2) One member with professional expertise in the field of addictive
 18 disorders.

19 (3) One member with professional expertise in the field of
 20 developmental disabilities.

21 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,
 22 business enterprise, or auditing.

23 (5) One member who represents either the judiciary, with particular
 24 emphasis on specialty courts; or law enforcement, school-based health care,
 25 public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the parishes.

26 (6) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 27 mental health appointed by the governor.

28 (7) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 29 addictive disorders appointed by the governor.

30 (8) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 31 developmental disabilities appointed by the governor.

32 C. The Central Louisiana Human Services District shall be governed by
 33 a board of eleven members who are residents of the eight parishes within the
 34 statutory governance area of the district. Eight members shall consist of one
 35 representative from each parish within the statutory governance area of the
 36 district who is appointed by the local governmental authority of the parish and
 37 three members shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

38 (1) One member with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

39 (2) One member with professional expertise in the field of addictive
 40 disorders.

41 (3) One member with professional expertise in the field of
 42 developmental disabilities.

43 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,
 44 business enterprise, or auditing.

45 (5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis
 46 on specialty courts.

47 (6) Three members who represent law enforcement, school-based health
 48 care, public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the respective
 49 appointing parishes.

50 (7) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 51 mental health appointed by the governor.

52 (8) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 53 addictive disorders appointed by the governor.

54 (9) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
 55 developmental disabilities appointed by the governor.

56 D. The Northwest Louisiana Human Services District shall be governed
 57 by a board of twelve members who are residents of the nine parishes within the
 58 statutory governance area of the district. Nine members shall consist of one
 59 representative from each parish within the statutory governance area of the

district who is appointed by the local governmental authority of the parish and three members shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

(1) Two members with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

(2) Two members with professional expertise in the field of addictive disorders.

(3) Two members with professional expertise in the field of developmental disabilities.

(4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting, business enterprise, or auditing.

(5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis on specialty courts.

(6) One member who represents law enforcement, school-based health care, public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the parishes.

(7) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of mental health appointed by the governor.

(8) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of addictive disorders appointed by the governor.

(9) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of developmental disabilities appointed by the governor.

E. Appointees shall serve terms of three years. No board member shall serve more than three consecutive three-year terms.

F. Effective January 1, 2018, all boards established pursuant to this Section shall comply with the enumerated requirements of expertise in this Section. Members serving on the board prior to January 1, 2018 who satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall be considered to have satisfied the requirement to serve and shall remain on the board for the duration of their unexpired term. Any board member who does not satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall be replaced by January 1, 2018, and the newly appointed member shall begin a new three-year term. It shall be the responsibility of the executive director of each district or authority provided for in this Section to ensure that the board of the district or authority satisfies the enumerated criteria herein. The executive director shall work with the local parish governmental authorities in the district's or authority's statutory governance area and with the governor to ensure compliance with the board requirements of this Section."

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 8, after line 25, delete the remainder of the page and on page 9 delete lines 1 through 22 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"A. The Jefferson Parish Human Services Authority shall be governed by a board of twelve members who are residents of Jefferson Parish. Nine members shall be appointed by the Jefferson Parish Council and three members shall be appointed by the governor as follows:

(1) Two members with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

(2) Two members with professional expertise in the field of addictive disorders.

(3) Two members with professional expertise in the field of developmental disabilities.

(4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting, business enterprise, or auditing.

(5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis on specialty courts.

(6) One member who represents law enforcement, school-based health care, public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the parish.

1 (7) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
2 mental health appointed by the governor.

3 (8) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
4 addictive disorders appointed by the governor.

5 (9) One member who is a parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of
6 developmental disabilities appointed by the governor.

7 B. Each member shall serve for a three-year term. No board member
8 shall serve more than two consecutive three-year terms.

9 C. Effective January 1, 2018, the board shall comply with the
10 enumerated requirements of expertise in this Section. Members serving on the
11 board prior to January 1, 2018 who satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall
12 be considered to have satisfied the requirement to serve and shall remain on the
13 board for the duration of their unexpired term. Any board member who does
14 not satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall be replaced by January 1, 2018,
15 and the newly appointed member shall begin a new three-year term. It shall be
16 the responsibility of the executive director to ensure that the board satisfies the
17 enumerated criteria herein. The executive director shall work with the
18 Jefferson Parish Council and the governor to ensure compliance with the board
19 requirements of this Section.

20 D. The Jefferson Parish attorney shall be the legal advisor for the
21 authority."

29 (1) One member with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

30 (2) One member with professional expertise in the field of addictive
31 disorders.

32 (3) One member with professional expertise in the field of
33 developmental disabilities.

34 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,
35 business enterprise, or auditing.

36 (5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis
37 on specialty courts.

38 (6) One member who represents law enforcement, school-based health

 11 shall be comprised of the following thirteen members:

 13 health.

14 (2) Two members with professional expertise in the field of addictive
 15 disorders.

16 (3) Two members with professional expertise in the field of
 17 developmental disabilities.

18 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,
 19 business enterprise, or auditing.

20 (5) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis

 49 included in the statutory governance area of the authority. The board shall be
 50 comprised of the following nine members:

51 (1) One member with professional expertise in the field of mental health.

52 (2) One member with professional expertise in the field of addictive
 53 disorders.

1 (3) One member with professional expertise in the field of
2 developmental disabilities.

3 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,

 16 among a list of qualified candidates nominated by the governing authority of
 17 each parish. The candidates from Ascension Parish shall be nominated by the
 18 parish president. The seventeen-member board shall be comprised as follows:

19 (1) Two members with professional expertise in the field of mental
 20 health.

21 (2) Two members with professional expertise in the field of addictive
 22 disorders.

23 (3) Two members with professional expertise in the field of
 24 developmental disabilities.

25 (4) One member with professional expertise in finance, accounting,
 26 business enterprise, or auditing.

27 (5) One member with professional expertise in the field of public health.

28 (6) One member who represents the judiciary, with particular emphasis
 29 on specialty courts.

30 (7) Two members who represent law enforcement, school-based health
 31 care, public health, or the coroner's office based on the needs of the respective
 32 appointing parishes.

33 (8) Two members who are parents, consumers, or advocates in the field
 34 of mental health.

35 (9) Two members who are parents, consumers, or advocates in the field
 36 of addictive disorders.

37 (10) Two members who are parents, consumers, or advocates in the field

39 B. Each appointment by the governor shall be submitted to the Senate
 40 for confirmation.

41 C. Each member shall serve for a three-year term. No board member
 42 shall serve more than three consecutive three-year terms.

43 D. Effective January 1, 2018, the board shall comply with the
 44 enumerated requirements of expertise in this Section. Members serving on the
 45 board prior to January 1, 2018 who satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall
 46 be considered to have satisfied the requirement to serve and shall remain on the
 47 board for the duration of their unexpired term. Any board member who does
 48 not satisfy one of the enumerated criteria shall be replaced by January 1, 2018,
