HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Miguez to Engrossed House Bill No. 93 by
Representative Miguez

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 11, change "B." to "B.(1)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 15, after "department." delete the remainder of the line, delete line 16
5 through 20 in their entirety, and insert the following:

6 "If the qualifying member was unable to purchase his firearm prior to his
7 death, an immediate family member listed in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection
8 has the right of first refusal to purchase the firearm unless the immediate
9 family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under the provisions
10 of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law.

11 (2) Unless the deceased officer has designated a specific immediate
12 family member as the beneficiary to purchase his firearm upon his death, the
13 following immediate family members have the right of first refusal to
14 purchase the firearm in the following order of precedence:

15 (a) The surviving spouse of the deceased officer.

16 (b) A child of the deceased officer. If more than one child seeks to
17 purchase the firearm, the oldest child who seeks to purchase the firearm
18 precedes all other children who seek to purchase the firearm in the right of
19 first refusal.

20 (c) A parent of the deceased officer.

21 (d) A sibling of the deceased officer. If more than one sibling seeks
22 to purchase the firearm, the oldest sibling who seeks to purchase the firearm
23 precedes all other siblings who seek to purchase the firearm in the right of
24 first refusal.

25 (3) If the firearm is part of an ongoing investigation or is being used
26 or is needed as evidence, the provisions of this Subsection do not apply until
27 the firearm is no longer part of the investigation or is longer needed or being
28 used as evidence. In such case, the immediate family member with the right
29 of first refusal to purchase the firearm may request the release of the firearm
30 pursuant to R.S. 15:41."

32 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 in their entirety

33 AMENDMENT NO. 4

34 On page 2, at the beginning of line 6, insert "A."

35 AMENDMENT NO. 5

36 On page 2, line 9, after "sheriff." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 10 through 17
37 in their entirety, and insert the following:

1 "If the qualifying sheriff or deputy sheriff was unable to purchase his firearm
 2 prior to his death, an immediate family member listed in Subsection B of this
 3 Section has the right of first refusal to purchase the firearm unless the
 4 immediate family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under the
 5 provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law.

6 B. Unless the deceased sheriff or deputy sheriff has designated a
 7 specific immediate family member as the beneficiary to purchase his firearm
 8 upon his death, the following immediate family members have the right of
 9 first refusal to purchase the firearm in the following order of precedence:

10 (1) The surviving spouse of the deceased sheriff or deputy sheriff.

11 (2) A child of the deceased sheriff or deputy sheriff. If more than
 12 one child seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest child who seeks to
 13 purchase the firearm precedes all other children who seek to purchase the
 14 firearm in the right of first refusal.

15 (3) A parent of the deceased sheriff or deputy sheriff.

16 (4) A sibling of the deceased sheriff or deputy sheriff. If more than
 17 one sibling seeks to purchase the firearm, the oldest sibling who seeks to
 18 purchase the firearm precedes all other siblings who seek to purchase the
 19 firearm in the right of first refusal.

29 On page 2, line 23, after "police." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 24 through
 30 29 in their entirety, and insert the following:

31 "If the qualifying municipal police officer was unable to purchase his firearm
 32 prior to his death, an immediate family member listed in Subsection B of this
 33 Section has the right of first refusal to purchase the firearm unless the
 34 immediate family member is prohibited from possessing a firearm under the
 35 provisions of R.S. 14:95.1 or any other state or federal law.

36 B. Unless the deceased officer has designated a specific immediate
 37 family member as the beneficiary to purchase his firearm upon his death, the
 38 following immediate family members have the right of first refusal to
 39 purchase the firearm in the following order of precedence:

40 (1) The surviving spouse of the deceased officer.

41 (2) A child of the deceased officer. If more than one child seeks to
 42 purchase the firearm, the oldest child who seeks to purchase the firearm
 43 precedes all other children who seek to purchase the firearm in the right of
 44 first refusal.

45 (3) A parent of the deceased officer.

46 (4) A sibling of the deceased officer. If more than one sibling seeks
 47 to purchase the firearm, the oldest sibling who seeks to purchase the firearm
 48 precedes all other siblings who seek to purchase the firearm in the right of
 49 first refusal.

50 C. If the firearm is part of an ongoing investigation or is being used
 51 or is needed as evidence, the provisions of this Subsection do not apply until
 52 the firearm is no longer part of the investigation or is longer needed or being
 53 used as evidence. In such case, the immediate family member with the right

7 in Subsection B of this Section of a law enforcement officer as defined by"

9 On page 3, line 8, after "officer" and before "to purchase" delete "shall be entitled" and insert
10 "has the right of first refusal"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 11

12 On page 3, line 9, after "agency" delete the remainder of the line, insert a comma "," and
13 insert "unless"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 12

15 On page 3, at the beginning of line 10, delete "provisions of this Section shall not apply if"

17 On page 3, line 12, after "law." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 13 and 14 in
18 their entirety, and insert the following:

22 purchase the firearm in the following order of precedence:
