Designates the parallel bridges crossing the Reserve Relief Canal on Interstate 10 in St. John the Baptist Parish as the "Spencer Chauvin Memorial Bridge".

Designates US 190 in West Baton Rouge Parish from the foot of the Mississippi River Bridge to its intersection with LA 415 as the "Trooper Francis C. Zinna Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.

Designates US 190 within the corporate limits of the town of Livonia, in Pointe Coupee Parish as the "Lawrence Russo Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting these designations provided local or private monies are received by the department, equal to the department's costs to erect each sign, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Effective August 1, 2017.

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation,</u> <u>Highways, and Public Works to the original bill</u>

1. Add designation of US 190 within the corporate limits of the town of Livonia, in Pointe Coupee Parish as the "Lawrence Russo Memorial Highway", notwithstanding any other law to the contrary.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and Public Works</u> to the <u>engrossed</u> bill:

1. Require local or private monies be received by the Dept. of Transportation and Development, equal to the department's costs to erect each sign, not to exceed \$550 per sign.
