

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 110

A RESOLUTION

To commend Orleans, Jefferson, St. Tammany, and St. Bernard parish chapters of Alliance for Good Government and to recognize May 24, 2017, as "Alliance for Good Government Day" at the Louisiana State Capitol.
