1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "Fisheries" delete the comma "," and insert "and"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 3, after "Forestry" delete the comma "," and the remainder of the line and  
5 delete line 4 in its entirety and on line 5, delete "be proposed in the future," and insert  
6 "evaluate any hog toxicant"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 5, after "Louisiana" delete the comma ","

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, at the end of line 6, delete "suspend" and delete line 7 in its entirety and insert  
11 "seek opportunities to cooperate where the exercise of each department's duties and  
12 responsibilities significantly impacts the other department."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, line 16, delete "management of feral hogs" and insert "feral hog management"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 27, and insert the following:

17           "WHEREAS, despite efforts to reduce the risk to other mammals, concerns  
18 continued as the toxicant's effects on the black bear, secondary intoxication of  
19 predators and scavengers, and effects on humans also prescribed Coumadin; and

20           WHEREAS, recognizing these issues, particularly the possible impact on the  
21 black bear only recently taken off the endangered species list, the commissioner of  
22 agriculture and forestry rescinded the registration of Kaput, rendering it ineligible  
23 for sale in Louisiana; and

24           WHEREAS, both a Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission resolution  
25 and a recommendation by the Louisiana Feral Hog Management Advisory Task  
26 Force called for a joint evaluation of any hog toxicant's impacts prior to use in this  
27 state; and

28           WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of the Department of Wildlife and  
29 Fisheries and the Department of Agriculture and Forestry often coincide as actions  
30 taken to manage wild animals often impact the management of domestic animals and  
31 vice versa; and

32           WHEREAS, the people of Louisiana, whether farmers or outdoorsmen and  
33 women, are well served when the decisions and resources of these departments align  
34 in cooperation for the betterment of both agricultural interests and the health and  
35 diversity of wild habitat."
